The project 4G Didactic Pills (2020-1-CZ01-KA201-078434) intends to develop and disseminate a pedagogic method, based on the theoretical foundation of the “Didactic Pill” focused on life skills, aiming to prevent and/or to face the early school leaving phenomenon. The aim is to develop a unique pattern flexible enough to be adapted to the specific contexts and conditions of the different regions and individual situations, with particular regard to students with SEN.





The activities – Teacher Training

The training curriculum is targeted for teachers, so that they can develop personal and professional learning in applying the theoretical framework and the proposed activities in practice. Teachers will find:

- Educational paths to improve and nurture life skills and emotional intelligence of their students for personal and professional development.
- Knowledge for the production of educational pills usable on mobile devices

Teacher training course (Training course-kit for teachers). It consists in the elaboration of a **curriculum based on life skills**, starting from the methodological kits developed in previous projects. The teaching methodology is based on microteaching and small interdisciplinary units so that students can work with images, videos and short sentences. This helps them understand and memorize, minimizing efforts and maximizing results.

- **Manual** for the production of educational pills usable on mobile devices. It aims to present **how an educational product for the formation of pills is produced**.
- During the training realized in May in Murcia by EUROACCION teachers learned how to set up and manage study material in the form of digital pills – experience emotional education – contribute to the elaboration of a curriculum. The teaching methodology is based on microteaching so that students can work with images, videos, and short sentences. This helps them understand minimizing efforts and maximizing results.
